

MY EVACUATION LIST

On “Red Flag” days when there is a higher risk of wildfire, be ready to evacuate on a moment’s notice. This includes backing your car into your driveway so that you can drive straight out, or parking your car on the street in the direction of your most likely used escape route. If you’re at home during a Red Flag day, be aware of things you can have at the ready, including:

For 5 minute evacuation notice
